

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1890
OFFERED BY MR. ROSKAM OF ILLINOIS

Page 34, after line 3, insert the following:

1 (19) COMMERCIAL PARTNERSHIPS.—

2 (A) IN GENERAL.—With respect to an
3 agreement that is proposed to be entered into
4 with the Transatlantic Trade and Investment
5 Partnership countries and to which section 3(b)
6 will apply, the principal negotiating objectives
7 of the United States regarding commercial
8 partnerships are the following:

9 (i) To discourage actions by potential
10 trading partners that directly or indirectly
11 prejudice or otherwise discourage commer-
12 cial activity solely between the United
13 States and Israel.

14 (ii) To discourage politically motivated
15 actions to boycott, divest from, or sanction
16 Israel and to seek the elimination of politi-
17 cally motivated non-tariff barriers on
18 Israeli goods, services, or other commerce
19 imposed on the State of Israel.

1 (iii) To seek the elimination of state-
2 sponsored unsanctioned foreign boycotts
3 against Israel or compliance with the Arab
4 League Boycott of Israel by prospective
5 trading partners.

6 (B) DEFINITION.—In this paragraph, the
7 term “actions to boycott, divest from, or sanc-
8 tion Israel” means actions by states, non-mem-
9 ber states of the United Nations, international
10 organizations, or affiliated agencies of inter-
11 national organizations that are politically moti-
12 vated and are intended to penalize or otherwise
13 limit commercial relations specifically with
14 Israel or persons doing business in Israel or in
15 Israeli-controlled territories.
